HOW TO BE A FILL-IN PLAYER

If a player wishes to play on a team but not as a fully registered player, they must register through our fill-in process.

For games where a fill-in player does not followed the below procedure and types their name on the tablet – the game will become an automatic forfeit for the fill-in team.

- 1. Use the following link to register as a fil-in player and pay necessary fees (\$13.00 casual game + BWA Insurance if not already a member): https://www.playhq.com/basketball-wa/register/1144b4
- 2. Lakeside Competitions team (<u>programs@lakeside.asn.au</u>) must be notified in advance so the player can be added to the team prior to the game.

Please email the following:

- Players full-name
- Team Name
- Age group & division

Important Notes:

Games played as a casual fill-in player <u>DO NOT</u> count towards finals eligibility – no player will be provided an exemption for games played as a fill in.

Players that are already fully registered to a team and are filling-in cannot be allocated on PlayHQ, hence will have to play without obtaining PlayHQ game stats.

If a player is going to plat as a fill-in and already plays in a Lakeside registered team, they must ensure the team they are filling-in for is <u>either a division or age group higher</u>. Players CANNOT play down in either age groups or divisions.

Players are also NOT allowed to play under a different players name and jersey number – this is for a variety of safety reasons, mainly that if a player becomes injured during the game, they will not be shown as 'on court' whilst the injury occurred, wavering their ability to claim on their BWA insurance.
